Meet Henry Fitzgibbons

Henry Fitzgibbons, who has more than 30 years of experience in building design, programming and planning, is serving as the architect for our parish center project. He was selected from a group of three qualified architects who were invited to interview to lead the project.

Henry serves as partner in charge with Soderstrom Architects, Ltd., a Portland-based architecture, planning and interior design firm that was founded in 1984. The firm offers comprehensive architectural services ranging from programming and design to construction administration. SDRA serves clients throughout the country with 32 employees including architects licensed in 17 states.

Henry's primary design focus has been on educational facilities, especially faith-based institutions. He received his bachelor's of architecture degree from the University of Oregon and earned his Certificate in Value Engineering Leadership in Energy &

Environmental Design (LEED). He is responsible for master planning projects at Jesuit High School, the Sisters of St. Mary of Oregon, Central Catholic High School and St. Pius X School.

Examples of Henry's work can be found throughout the Oregon area: the kindergarten and library addition at St. John Fisher in Portland, the Performing Arts Center and Center for Science and Mathematics at Jesuit High School in Portland, the Parish Hall expansion at St. Matthew Catholic Church in Hillsboro and the pre-school expansion at Our Lady of Sorrows in Portland.
